We start with our original brown and white clay bodies, then form, glaze, trim, and fire each plate, bowl, mug, and serving piece as we always have. We create durable, quality pieces for the table, meant to be enjoyed every day. Or as we like to think about it: simple, good things for good people.

We design dinnerware lines, shapes, and glaze colors to go together, to be timeless and enduring, and to work as sets or mixed with a collection over time. Our latest offerings—the Tartine Collection and refreshed glazes for our accessories lines—are no exception. We take pride in the idea that our pieces interact so seamlessly that it's often hard to tell what's old, and what's new.



Heath doesn't just go well with other Heathware, it also works well with Heath and non-Heath vintage treasures, flea market finds, and a wide range of table settings.






COUPE LINE








RIM LINE










CHEZ PANISSE LINE

Beloved of architects, designers and homeowners alike, Heath Tile — made in Heath's San Francisco tile factory — is a pure expression of our love of beautiful materials. Our perfectly imperfect tiles are made by real people, glazed using traditional techniques, and fired and finished by Heath every step of the way. The iconic aesthetic, distinctive shapes, and broad palette allows for truly unique, varied and individual installations ranging from home environments to large-scale public spaces.

We bring together hard-to-find pieces from a variety of small, independent designers and makers. Rugs





TABLEWARE POLICIES

Ordering Guidelines

Many of our items are in stock and ready to go home with you. Occasionally, because of the handcrafted nature of our products, we may need time to make the clay, form the piece, fire and glaze it, and then get the finished pieces on their way to you.

Variation

All of our items are inspected by hand, as we take great care in the satisfaction of our customers and quality of our products. Irregularities and variation in glaze color are inherent due to the handcrafted nature of our pieces. We feel that these characteristics add to the natural beauty and unique quality of our products and are in no way to be considered flaws.

Quality + Care

Our dinnerware is microwave, oven and dishwasher safe if used properly. It should not, however, be placed over direct heat, heated to over 400°, or shocked from one extreme (hot/cold) temperature to another. To remove marks left by silverware, we suggest using Bar Keepers Friend—available for purchase in stores and online, and in most major hardware stores.

Shipping

Orders are shipped UPS Ground. We do not ship to PO boxes due to UPS shipping restrictions. For expedited order requests, please contact our Customer Service team for details and rates. We'll do our best to accommodate, depending on our inventory.

Damage or Breakage

We warranty our products for up to one year from purchase for proven defects in manufacture. Any breakage upon shipping must be reported to our Customer Service team within five days. We will re-ship your product once UPS has obtained possession of the package and the products are available for shipment.

Exchanges

We are happy to exchange items within 30 days of purchase for store credit or exchange. We cannot offer refunds. Please ensure items show no signs of use. All exchanges must be accompanied with a receipt or original packing slip and an Exchange Authorization Form, available online or through Customer Service. Exchanges without proof of payment will be processed at factory seconds pricing. All furniture sales are final. Heath is not responsible for any damage that occurs when return shipping, so we strongly encourage you to pack the items well and ship via FedEx or UPS. Please note shipping costs are non-refundable.

To the Trade

Trade discounts are available if you are a restaurant, hotel, designer, architect, or other industry specifier. All Trade customers must set up an account with a Heath representative by providing a resale license or tax ID number. Minimum order is \$500 (COGs only).
